

Must-visits

Olite/Erriberri

Although the **Royal Palace** is the number one reason to visit Olite, it's equally true that there could be no better setting for the palace to shine



in than this charming old town. It's a tapestry of robust ancestral homes with imposing coats of arms on their facades, Roman walls, Gothic arcades and beautiful churches.

Ujué/Uxue

Narrow cobbled streets lined with stone houses, the **church-cum-fortress** of Santa María de Ujué at the top of the hill and amazing views of both the Ribera region and the Pyrenees.



Valdorba

Home to valuable treasures of rural Romanesque religious and civil architecture.



Artajona

El Cercado de Artajona is an 11th century fortification. Visiting the church and climbing up to see the inverted roof is a very interesting experience.




Puente la Reina/ Gares

This **octagonal church** on the Way of St James is considered a Romanesque gem.




Monastery of Santa María la Real de la Oliva

Gastronomy

Known as the 'Navarra wine capital', Olite is the headquarters of the Navarra Wine Regulatory Council, the Navarra Wine Station (EVENA) and the Brotherhood of Navarra Wine. The good reputation of the wines made in the Olite area is well deserved, and not just that of the local whites, rosés, young reds, crianzas, reservas and gran reservas, but also its well-known muscadel, which are also produced under the Navarra Designation of Origin. This district is on the **Navarra Wine Route**.

You just have to try the local **red beans, migas** (shepherds' breadcrumbs) from Ujué and the wild mushrooms found in the area, not to mention the **truffles** unearthed in the forests of La Valdorba. The lands of the Central Zone are so generous that nobody can eat and drink everything fresh, so lots of fruit and vegetables have to be canned or preserved in jars, such as the well-known Navarrese asparagus. They don't lose any of their rich nutritional properties as a result. Don't miss the **garripiñadas** (caramelized almonds) from Ujué and the **pine nut toffees** from Tafalla.



WHAT TO SEE



1 Tafalla
Churches of Santa María and San Pedro, and the Palace of Los Mencos.

2 Olite/Erriberri
The Royal Palace, Old Palace (Parador Nacional –heritage hotel), Church of Santa María la Real, Tower of El Chapitel, Church of San Pedro, Enozentrum Olite/Erriberri.

3 San Martín de Unx
Mediaeval village, Church of San Martín de Tours and Romanesque crypt, Church of Nuestra Señora del Pópolo.

4 Ujué/Uxue
Mediaeval village included in the list of 'Most beautiful villages in Spain', Church-fortress of Santa María la Real.

5 Pitillas
Bird observatory and wetland.

6 Santacara
Roman site of Cara.

7 Carcastillo
Monastery of Santa María la Real de la Oliva.

8 Rada
Walled enclosure of Rada.

9 Artajona
Cerco de Artajona walled enclosure, Church-fortress of San Saturnino, Portillo de Enériz and Mina de Farangortea dolmens.

10 Berbinzana
Museum and Iron Age archaeological site of Las Eretas.

11 Mendigorría
Museum and Roman archaeological site of Andelos.

12 Olcoz
Mediaeval tower of Olcoz.

13 Muruzábal
Church octogonal of Santa María de Eunate.

14 Puente la Reina/Gares
Mediaeval Way of St James village, churches of El Crucifijo and Santiago, Romanesque bridge.

15 Olóriz
Chapel of San Pedro ad Vincula in Echano.

16 Orísoain
Church of San Martín de Tours and Romanesque crypt, Experiences of Yesteryear eco-museum.

17 Garínoain
Church of Santo Cristo de Catalán.

18 Iratxeta
Granary.

19 Olleta
Church of La Asunción.
